The Board of Alderman of the City of Golden City, Missouri met in regular session at 6:00 p.m. on November 01, 2021 at 701 Depot Avenue. Mayor Higgins presided and the following members of the Board of Alderman answered the roll call: Linda Welch, Sharon Wingert, Vicky Jones, Carla Davis, and Sara Beerly. Other city officials present were City Clerk Breeyn Pettengill, Public Works Director Allen Singer, and Fire Chief Eric White.

Minutes:

Wingert moved, seconded by Jones, the minutes of the Regular Session of October 04, 2021, be approved as presented. All in favor, and motion carried.

Public Participation:

Jacob Wilson addressed the board concerning following the ATV ordinance. Mayor Higgins informed Mr. Wilson that if you are in city limits you must follow the ordinances. Mayor Higgins also informed him that the board would review the ordinance and determine if they needed to be modified.

Public Works Department:

Fire Department: Chief White submitted a report prior to the meeting. Beerly motioned, second by Welch, to approve payment of \$836.31 to DryFork Diesel for batteries and brakes for the Stewart Stevenson. All in favor, motion carried.

Chief White informed the board that the department has an ISO audit coming up.

Public Works Director Singer submitted a report prior to the meeting. Discussion was held. Beerly made a motion to remove the dead trees in the park there was a second by Jones. All in favor, motion carried. Discussion was held on the bid opening performed by Anderson Engineering. Mayor Higgins read the sole bid as well as the recommended statements submitted by Anderson Engineering. Beerly motioned, second by Davis, to reject the bid from Sprouls Engineering. Jones, Beerly, Welch, Davis, and Wingert aye. Motion carried. Singer will meet with committee to explore other options and they will bring alternatives back to the board next meeting. Discussion was held on the need for monthly gravel and the cost to keep it on hand. Davis motioned, second by Jones, to make the purchase of a bucket of gravel variable price that would fluctuate with the city's cost. All in favor motion carried. Discussion was held on brush pickup. Brush pick up will now be available once a month sometime between the first and fifth of every month.
