

CITY OF GOLDEN CITY

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The Board of Aldermen of the City of Golden City, Missouri met in regular session at 6:00 p.m. on April 5, 2021, at 701 Depot Avenue. Mayor Shannon Higgins presided, and the following members of the Board of Aldermen answered the roll call: Sharon Wingert, Carla Davis, Vicky Jones, Sara Beerly and Chris Peterson. Linda Welch absent. Other city officials present were City Clerk Breeyn Pettengill, Fire Chief Eric White, and Public Works Director Allen Singer.

MINUTES: *Davis moved, second by Wingert, the minutes of the Regular Session of March 1, 2021, be approved as presented. All in favor, Welch absent. Motion carried.*

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION:

Denise Carmean would like to place a carport in her driveway. The carport would be placed just inside the right of way for the city. Director Singer explained that he foresees no issues as there are no lines and the right of way is especially wide. It was also explained that should a need arise Ms. Carmean may have to move the carport. Discussion was held. *Peterson motioned to allow the carport to be placed on Ms. Carmean's land, Wingert seconded. Four in favor, 1 abstained, Welch absent.*

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

Mayor Higgins informed the board that MoDOT did not approve the city's application for a TAP Grant. He informed the board that the city was denied since the city had no more money to put forth.

DEPARTMENTAL REPORTS:

FIRE: Chief White submitted a report before the meeting. Chief White presented three quotes for new tires to go on Rescue 1. *Davis motioned, seconded by Beerly, to purchase new tires for Rescue 1 from Brian's Auto not to exceed \$1150.00. All in favor, Welch absent.*

PUBLIC WORKS: Director Singer submitted a report before the meeting. Discussion was held on summer help. *Wingert motioned to put an ad in the paper for seasonal help consisting of light maintenance and mowing with pay starting at \$9.00 an hour. Davis seconded. All in favor, Welch absent.*

SHERIFF DEPARTMENT: No logs or report was submitted.

NEW BUSINESS: Discussion was held on the infrastructure of 524 Main Street. Discussion was held on the sidewalk on the North side of Main Street. No decisions were made at this time.

Peterson made a motion to pay the bills, second by Wingert, all in favor, Welch absent, motioned carried.

Peterson moved, seconded by Beerly, the meeting be adjourned. All in favor, Welch absent, motioned carried. (19:19)
